#### PTA: We need you!

We would not be able to afford the minibus and the cost of most trips would almost double: at least 1 coach per year in each class is subsidised by the PTA. We are not asking people to become fully fledged members or take on a role but if you can spare a couple of hours to volunteer or contribute it would be much appreciated.

#### <u>Attendance</u>

I apologise for repeating the attendance message but for a number of weeks we have been below the national expectation of 96%. Please make every effort to ensure your child attends school everyday. Attendance of 90% over the year ,although may sound good, is equivalent to 4 weeks off school. We appreciate your support in this area.

#### Invacuation drill.

As part of our ongoing work to safeguard our pupils we have a planned invacuation drill on the 4th July.

Invacuation procedures may be activated in response to any number of situations. For example:

1. A reported incident, disturbance in the local community.

2. A warning being received regarding a local risk of air pollution (smoke plume, gas cloud etc.)

3. An intruder on site.

4. A major fire in the vicinity of the school.

5. The close proximity of an unaccompanied animal eg a dog.

Our procedures aim to minimise disruption to the learning environment whilst ensuring the safety of all children and staff.


