## Homework

Children will start the Success For All Phonics programme on Monday 15th September. A parent meeting will be held the same day, 6:00–6:30pm, to explain phonics teaching, progression, and home support. Weekly reading books, plus a shared reader on Fridays, must be re-read at home to reinforce learning and progress.

## School Trips

Reception will be going on a trip to Hesketh Farm on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May. A letter with further details will follow closer to the time.

## P.E Days

Reception P.E. lessons take place on Wednesday mornings, starting 17th September. Children should come dressed in their P.E. kit instead of school uniform. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name to help return belongings at the end of the day.

## Buddies

In Reception each child is allocated a Year 6 'buddy' who will meet the children on their start date and will look after them at playtimes

## Reading Books

Reading books go home twice weekly. Return books on Monday morning for changing after an adult read on Tuesday. Bring them back by Thursday to be read, changed, and sent home Friday. Ensure books are returned Mondays and Thursdays to support your child's reading progress.

## Reminders

- Learning begins **promptly at 08:45**. Please say your goodbyes at the bottom playground and allow your child to enter the classroom independently.
- Please make sure everything that your child brings into school is named and labelled. It makes returning lost items much easier.
- Children should bring a water bottle into school that should have their name written on. They will have access to these water bottles throughout the day.
