Top Playground Appeal Update

We are delighted to share that, in just over a year, our school community has raised an amazing £9,219.99 towards the resurfacing of the top playground. A huge thank you to everyone who has supported the appeal so far—whether through fundraising ideas, giving up your time, or cheering us on along the way and the wonderful team who has worked with Mrs Parker to push the appeal forwards.

On Monday, Mrs Parker had a promising call with the council. They are now working on submitting a bid for grant funding to cover the remaining costs. We'll be keeping our fingers crossed—if the bid is successful, the work could begin much sooner than expected, which is very exciting news for our children and our local community!

Our next big fundraising event is the Santa Dash on Wednesday 17th December, guaranteed to get everyone into the Christmas spirit.

Santa Dash

We are excited to announce that we will be hosting our first ever Santa Dash on the afternoon of Wednesday 17th December, with all proceeds going towards the top playground appeal. There is an entry fee of £5 payable via Arbor in the shop section and each child taking part will receive a Santa hat and beard to wear during the event. Children will complete a festive obstacle course around the top playground, with distances adjusted appropriately for different year groups. Once they have finished the Santa Dash, they will be able to enjoy either a hot chocolate or squash. Please add a note when buying the ticket with the drink option your child would like. Children should come to school on the day in suitable running bottoms e.g. leggings tracksuit bottoms and trainers and they can wear a Christmas jumper.
